Development Issue 1-1 Response to the Humanitarian Crisis	[Background and current situation] Since January 2015, more than nine years of conflict have destroyed basic infrastructure, impoverishing the lives of the population, and the economic crisis has delayed the government's provision of basic administrative services. The UN Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) for Yemen 2024 identifies 18.2 million people as those in need of assistance.However, in recent years, the gap in humanitarian assistance funding has been exacerbating..According to the OCHA, only USD 1.66 billion (38.3% of the required 4.34 billion USD) was provided in 2023. In light of the vast humanitarian needs in Yemen, the United Nations and concerned countries are calling for the importance of support from the international community.
